# CHANGES TO OUR FLU CLINIC CAMPAIGN FOR 2020

- **Due to COVID-19 we have taken the safest approach for our patients as possible this year.**
- **Social distancing must be adhered to. Please ensure you are wearing a mask.**
- **Children's Flu Vaccine – Only one parent will be admitted into the building with the child due to receive their flu vaccine. Please do not bring other children with you to the appointment.**
- **Please arrive on time, not too early or late. We must adhere strictly to social distancing and ensure clinics run as smoothly and safely as possible.**

# PATIENTS 65 YRS AND OVER

## FLUAD VACCINE

- Patients will now need to phone the surgery for a nurse appmt for this vaccine-we still have a small supply.
- Any patients who book into these clinics, and are **under 65 years, the appointment will be cancelled.**

# PATIENTS 'AT RISK' UNDER 65 YEARS QUADRIVALENT VACCINE

- Quadrivalent Vaccine is now in stock. Please note clinics will be over the next few weeks, due to the supplier delivering in smaller batches.
- Clinic dates commencing Friday 9 October.
- Appointments are available on-line with Dr Quadrivalent.
- Please ensure you arrive on time for your appointment and wear a mask, maintaining social distancing at all times.

# CHILDREN AGE 2 & 3 YEARS FLUENZ TETRA

- We have received our first delivery of Fluenz.
- Appointments are available to book now.
- Texts have been sent to patients where we have a mobile number.
- Please ensure you only bring the child who is receiving their Fluenz.
- Strict social distancing is in place, please wear a mask and arrive on time for your appmt.

# PATIENTS OVER 50 AND UNDER 65 NOT AT RISK

- We have received the following statement for patient information:
- ***Please note that people in the 50-64-year old age group will not be vaccinated until November and December, providing there is sufficient vaccine, and no appointments will be offered for this age group until then. This is to ensure that those who are most at risk are vaccinated first. If you are 50-64 and you are in one of the other groups which is eligible for the flu vaccination, for example you have a health condition which puts you at risk from the flu, you will be invited earlier.***
